Confidentiality

Personal medical information, such as diagnosis, is confidential and <u>will not</u> be shared with your employer or local union, unless you authorize it.

Next Steps

Please have the following forms completed and returned to Desjardins Insurance. These forms should be returned within 2 weeks of your initial call with Desjardins.

- 1. The Attending Physician Statement is to be completed by your physician. Please have your physician determine which form (i.e. physical vs psychological) is most appropriate based on your condition(s).
- 2. The Authorization is to be completed by you.

Desjardins will pay up to \$80.00 for completion of the Attending Physician's Statement. You may submit a receipt for reimbursement, or your physician may send an invoice directly to Desjardins. Any amount over \$80.00 will be your responsibility.
